Selected applicants will be invited for an in-person audition at Soulpepper Theatre (**Toronto**, **ON**) and will be asked to prepare a *two-minute monologue from a published play of their choosing.* 

All submissions must be received by **Sunday November 2, 2025**, by **11:59PM ET**. Early submissions are encouraged.

Invitations for auditions will be sent no later than Friday November 14, 2025 by 5PM ET.
