VENUE AND LOCATION

Auditions will take place in-person audition at the Young Centre for the Performing Arts at **50 Tank House Lane, Toronto, ON M5A 3C4**.

Please enter through the main atrium (the lobby) of the Young Centre. Someone will be onsite at the front desk to check you in and escort you to the hall. If you are running late, please email our Associate Producer, Julia Carrano, at casting@soulpepper.ca.

IMPORTANT NOTE FOR GETTING TO THE VENUE: The Distillery Winter Village will be active on this day. While no ticket is required to access the site, we recommend entering via the **designated Young Centre patron lane off Cherry Street**. **Please allow for additional travel time**, as traffic in and around the Distillery District is often highly congested during this event.
