Stories disarm, nudge empathy and engage our imaginations viscerally reminding us of when we were all a little more supple. Stories can heal.

Bad Parent was developed with the participation of Banff Playwrights Lab, Soulpepper Theatre Company, Vancouver Asian Canadian Theatre (vAct), and Prairie Theatre Exchange (PTE).

BACKGROUND NOTES

A new play by Ins Choi is so anticipated that three theatre companies collaborated on its first production. *Bad Parent*'s rolling 'premiere' was set to begin in Winnipeg at Prairie Theatre Exchange and Vancouver at the Vancouver Asian Canadian Theatre, but with schedule changes it now lands first here, in Toronto. Mind you, Choi is no stranger to Toronto audiences.. Mind you, Choi is no stranger to our audiences. He's graced our stage as an actor, and he also created *Kim's Convenience*, a play that won national acclaim, and then became a television show that went around the world. We're delighted to have his sharp storytelling back at Soulpepper.

Choi loves to explore family dynamics, focusing here on the life-changing experience of early parenthood with his signature mix of heart and humour. Funny thing: parenting is one of the most important roles we take on in life, but there's no real preparation for it. You leave the hospital with a small human being in your possession and, stunningly, nobody verifies your fitness for the job; you don't even have to sign any papers.

As the play makes comically clear, the first months with your first child are a process of trial and error undertaken on hormones with little to no sleep. Not only do new parents have to figure out how to keep this tiny, demanding creature alive, they must also meet their own individual needs (including physiological ones like the occasional shower), while reconfiguring their identities and their partnership in light of new realities.

Two theatrical decisions nourish this comedy, both connected to point of view. There are 2 actors on stage, and both play 2 parts. The actress plays Norah, the mother, and Nora the Filipinx nanny Norah hires. The actor plays Charles, the father, and Dale, the co-worker Norah bonds with after she returns to work. Each actor embodies a parent in the trenches, and a witness to that struggle. Speaking of witnesses, Charles and Norah talk directly to us, their audience. Each wants us on their side, needs us on their side. Their fierce competition for our allegiance drives the play.

This is a theatrical device, but it reflects reality, too. When you're a new parent, it can sometimes feel like everyone's got an opinion on what you should do from friends and family to complete strangers on the street. They all feel free to give advice. You are free too. Free to take sides, change sides, and laugh, loud and long and often.






