There are these rare playwrights who can capture, as Chekhov called it, **the form and pressure of our time**.

I read this play on my 40th birthday. Coming out of the pandemic I had been connecting with old friends, and my American family. The play started like one of these chats - fun, familiar, but skirting around something bigger - the reckoning of what it is to live through something historical, with being at the

precipice of something, a crossroads.

Then I sat with the play and realized the depth of what Branden Jacobs-Jenkins is asking us to do, here, in the theatre tonight. To take this liminal space of the porch and to fill it with *truth*: With real desire, and ugliness, and humour and the messy human need for meaning and connection and to change and to stay the same. It takes a formidable cast. And the performers here tonight are just that: a group of Soulpepper actors, at the top of their game, who are just aging into these complicated roles.

The way that *time* operates in this play is fascinating. Time is a theatrical force, the ticking clock on the evening; time is a unifier, the siren song of nostalgia; and time is a destroyer of worlds, for all of the historical violence that's touched on in the story, the characters are really being chased down by the great, humble, panoptic violence: that we all grow old.

I think we are in the hands of a generational playwright.
